

RY Floor Decal Installation & Maintenance



- FOR BEST ADHESION, CLEAN AND PREP SURFACE THOROUGHLY PRIOR TO APPLICATION
- FLOOR DECALS SHOULD BE APPLIED AT TEMPERATURES BETWEEN 40°F 90°F (4.44°C 32.22°C)
- DO NOT SCRUB, WAX. OR POLISH GRAPHIC FOR 24 HOURS AFTER APPLICATION

Suitable Floor Types

Avery floor decals are designed to be applied to smooth indoor surfaces. This system was developed for commercial tile floors but may be used on sealed concrete, sealed wood, and certain ceramic tile.

Avoiding Tripping Hazards

For best results, the decal should be applied to floors in good condition. To minimize potential tripping hazards, follow the tips below:




uneven surfaces or broken tiles.



Do not apply to rough, Do not apply over wide gaps between tiles.



Keep edges out of gaps between tiles.



Reapply or replace decals that bubble or pucker.



Replace decals that have lifted edges or excessive wear.



PREPARATION

Floor surface must be clean and adequately dry prior to application of decal. Your flooring must be firmly attached to the subfloor. Before applying this product, we recommend you first test this product in an "inconspicuous area" to assure suitability of the decal for your specific flooring.



APPLICATION

Once your floor is adequately prepped, follow these steps to ensure best results:


Step 1. Peel





Peel the backing paper (release liner) 1" from the top of the sheet and crease to expose a thin strip of adhesive.

Step 2. Apply



Carefully position the decal. Adhere the exposed edge to the floor. Pull the liner away, applying the decal as you go.

Step 3. Squeegee



Using a squeegee, start at the middle of the decal and work out toward the edges with firm pressure to remove trapped air.



A Do not clean, scrub, wax or polish for at least 24 hours.



MAINTENANCE

- When selecting a floor wax, ensure it meets or exceeds ASTM D 2047 standards for appropriate static coefficient of friction (.5 min). This ensures proper slip resistance.
- Prevent damage to decals by avoiding heavy-equipment traffic (i.e. fork lifts, pallets).



Avoid risk of injury by immediately removing a decal with a lifted edge!



REMOVAL

- To remove decal start at one edge and pull at an angle less than 45 degrees, using short quick strokes. If wax is accumulated around the edge, a putty knife may be required to lift the decal's edge.
- To remove in smaller sections, use a knife to slit the edge and remove each section separately.
- Decal removal may pull up some of the wax on tile floors. Clean and re-wax that area to create a level surface.

NOTE: For easier removal, apply light heat to one edge of the decal as you pull up.



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
