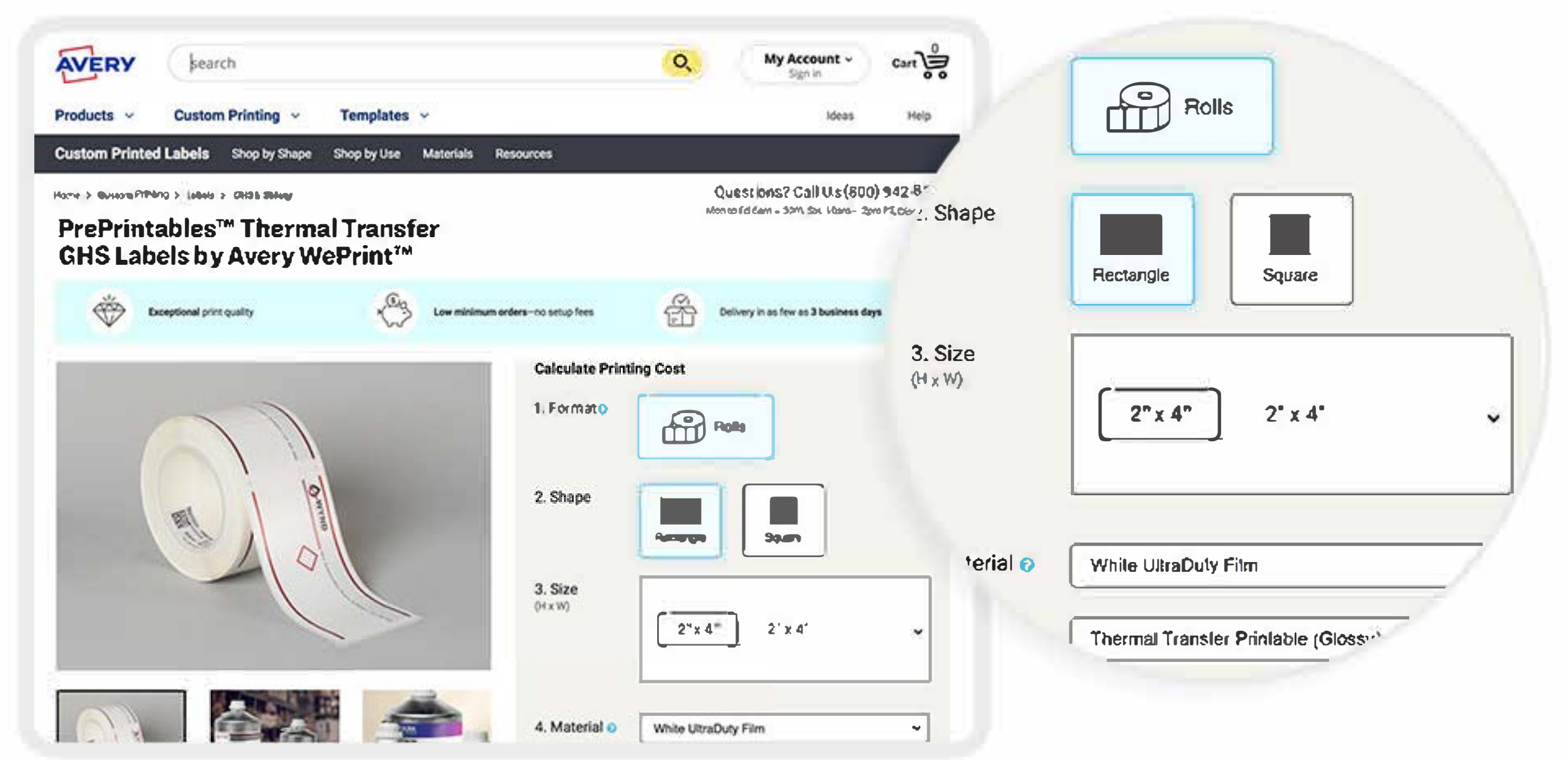
Step 1: Create & Order Your Preprinted Labels

Ships in **3 business days** after approval.

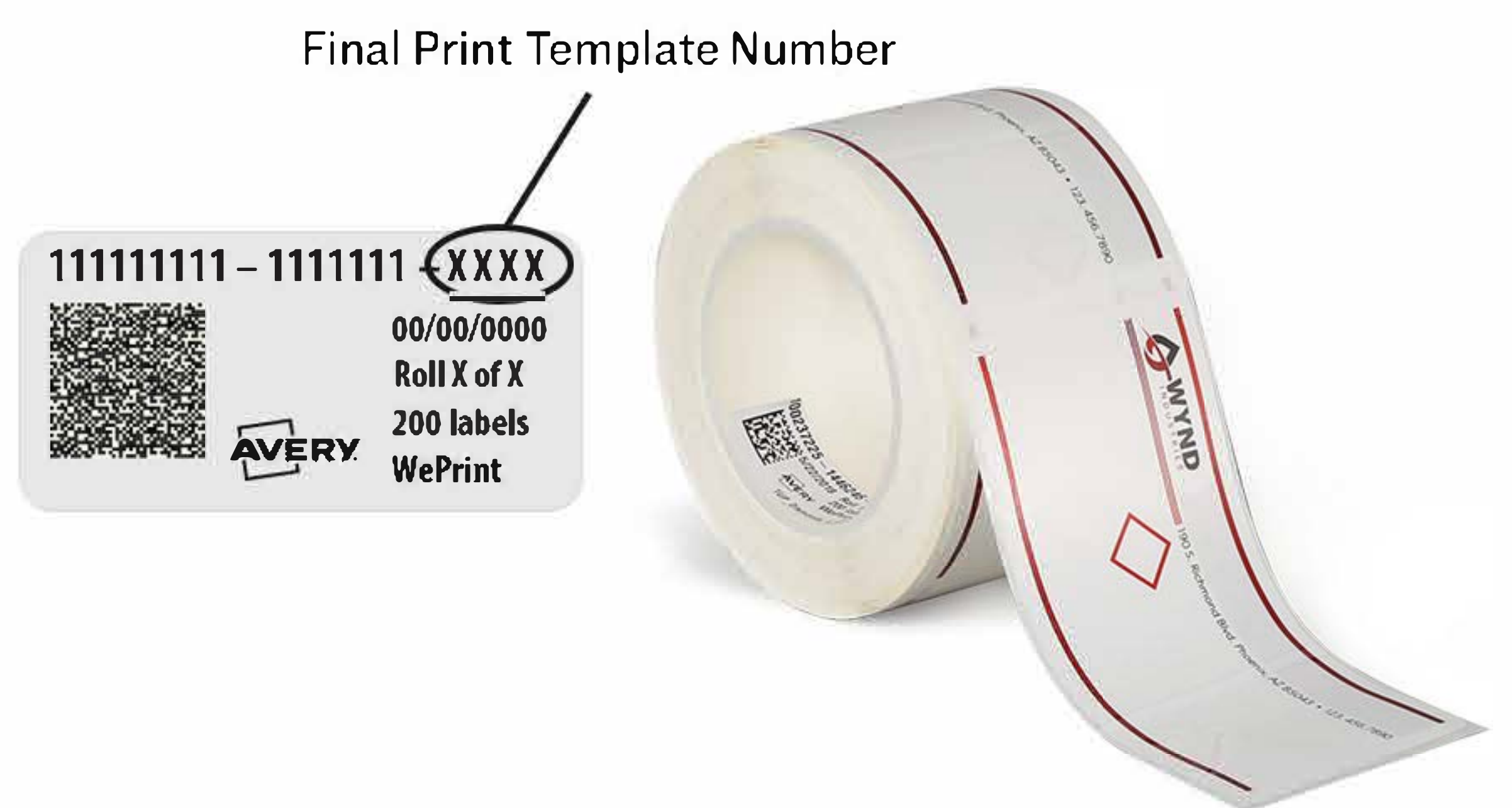


Step 2: Add Your Final Print Using Avery Design & Print Online

Locate your Final Print Template Number

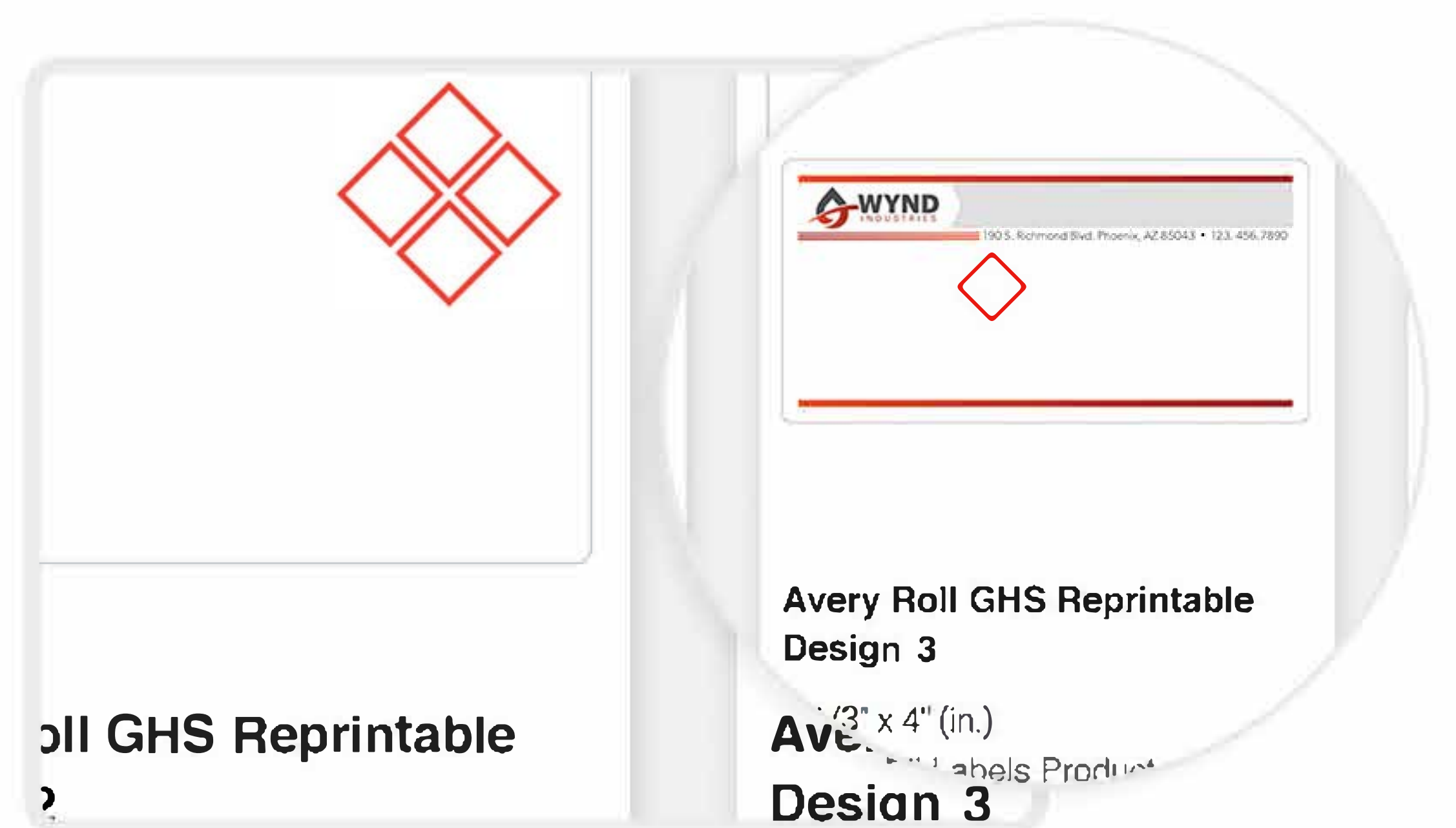
When you're ready to add the Final Print to your labels, find the template number on the inside your roll label core.

Access your Final Print Template

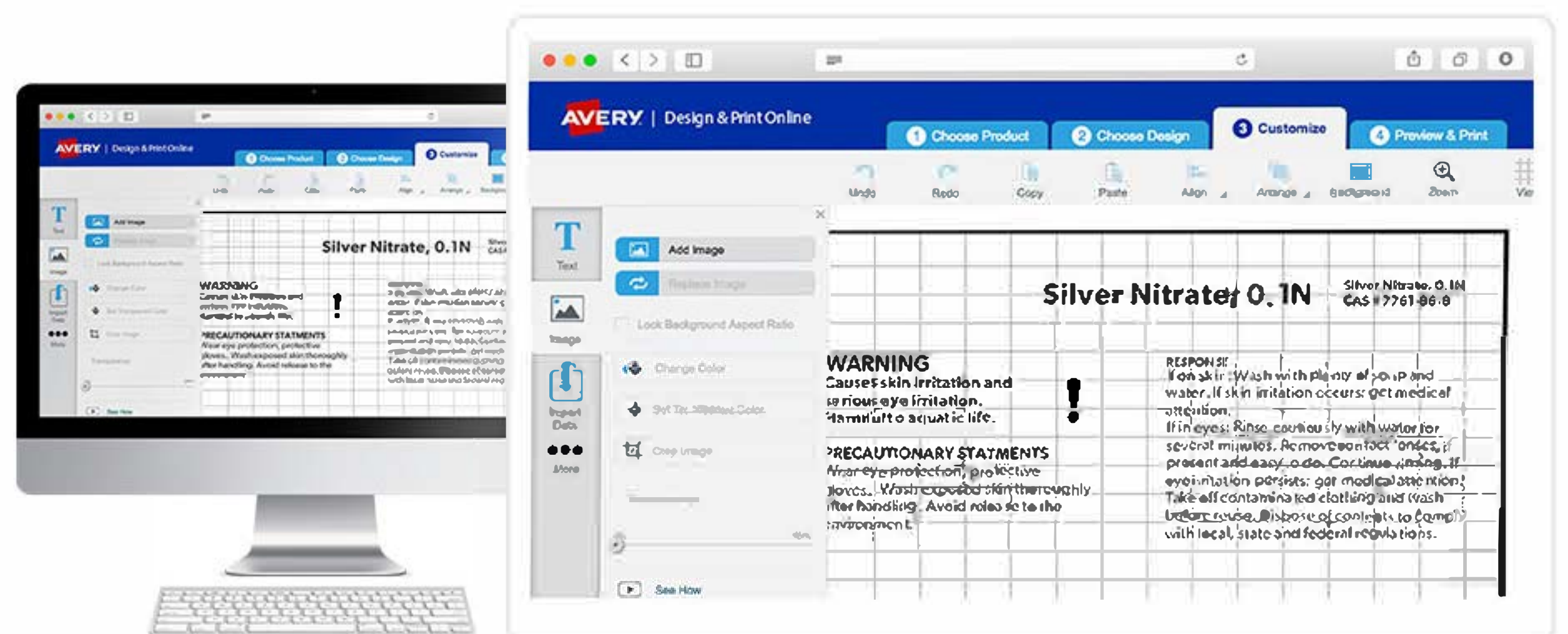
There will be a tab in your Avery Account named Final Print Templates. Match template number located on the core of your roll labels to the file in the Final Print Templates tab. Select the file and click **Create your Final Print**.

Use your thermal transfer printer to print directly from Design & Print Online, or download a .pdf file for printing at your convenience.
